We are pleased to announce that diagnostic images contributed by Grand River Hospital to the Southwestern Ontario Diagnostic Imaging Network (SWODIN) have been integrated with ClinicalConnect.

As a reminder, please use Internet Explorer 9+, Safari 6.0+, Google Chrome 20+ and Firefox 14+ when viewing SWODIN images. To view diagnostic images, click the camera icon in the Radiology Module in ClinicalConnect. Some Citrix corporate environments may not support compatible browsers so you may need to launch SWODIN images outside of Citrix.
