

## Hospital Report Manager

We are pleased to announce recent successful integrations of Hospital Report Manager (HRM) with ten hospital sites in south west Ontario (SWO). This brings the total of successful go-lives in SWO to 39. HRM is a solution that enables sending facilities (hospitals and independent health facilities) to securely deliver patient records into clinicians' certified electronic medical records (EMRs). HRM is also sending eNotifications (electronic messages whenever a patient is admitted or discharged from a hospital's Emergency Department or an in-patient unit) and Ontario Telemedicine Network telehomecare reports to an increasing number of regions in Ontario.

The connecting South West Ontario (cSWO) Program, in collaboration with OntarioMD, and the cSWO Change Management & Adoption Delivery Partners (CM&A DPs), continue to work with the remaining acute hospital sites across south west Ontario to integrate HRM. Outside of south west Ontario, there are already 75 locations live on HRM sending more than 400,000 clinical reports a month to clinician EMRs.

The four CM&A DPs and OntarioMD's field team are working with clinicians to implement HRM in their practices so they can receive patient reports directly to their EMRs. Currently, across south west Ontario, there are over 435 clinicians connected to HRM.

The Centre for Family Medicine Family Health Team (CFFM FHT) eHealth Centre of Excellence is the Change Management and Adoption Delivery Partner (CM&A DP) for the Waterloo Wellington Local Health Integration Network and is responsible for the deployment of cSWO Program services.
